Copy and cut out these Bible passages showing Jesus Christ's humanity and divinity. Fold and put in a basket. Have students take turns picking a slip, reading it and deciding if it shows Jesus' humanity or divinity. What in the passages proves it?

<p>And she [Mary] gave birth to her firstborn son [Jesus] and wrapped him in cloth and laid him in a manger. (Luke 2:7)</p>	<p>Jesus was about thirty years old when he began his work. (Luke 3:23)</p>	<p>(In the desert) where for forty days he [Jesus] was tempted by the devil. He ate nothing during those days, and at the end of the he was hungry. (Luke 4:2)</p>	<p>And he [Jesus] said to them [Disciples], "I have eagerly desired to eat this Passover with you before I suffer." (Luke 22:15)</p>	<p>Jesus called out with a loud voice, "Father into your hands I commit my spirit." When he had said this, he breathed his last. [died] (Luke 23:46)</p>
<p>Jesus reached out his hand and touched the man. "I am willing," and he said "Be clean!" And immediately the leprosy left him. (Luke 5:13)</p>	<p>(Jesus and Disciples in boat) "Master, Master, we're going to drown!" He [Jesus] got up and rebuked the wind and the raging waters; the storm subsided and all was calm. (Luke 8:24)</p>	<p>(Feeding 5,000) And he [Jesus] directed the [5,000] people to sit down on the grass. Taking the five loaves and the two fish and looking up to heaven, he gave thanks and broke the loaves...they all ate and were satisfied. (Matthew 14:19-20)</p>	<p>During the fourth watch of the night Jesus went out to them [Disciples in boat], walking on the lake. (Matthew 14:25)</p>	<p>(At the tomb of Jesus Christ) He [Jesus] is not here; he has risen! (Luke 24: 6)</p>
